**What are some of the names
of Jesus in the Greek
New Testament?**

Jesus the Christ

- **Jesus** - Ἰησοῦς (Jesus) is the Greek form of the Hebrew name Yeshua (יֵשׁוּעַ) [English “Joshua”] which means “Yahweh is salvation”
- **of Nazareth** – the town in which He grew up
- **Jesus (Joshua) Son of Joseph (English)**
Yehoshua ben Yosef (Hebrew), Yeshua bar Yosef (Aramaic)
- **Christ** - Christ is from Greek word "Christos" meaning "The Anointed One." In Hebrew, Christ is translated "Messiah."
- **Yeshua HaMashiach** – Hebrew for “Jesus the Messiah”

- Christos **Χριστός** The Anointed One Matthew 1:16, 16:16-20; Mark 8:29; Luke 2:11, 9:20; John 1:41, 4:42

The Name of Salvation

- Jesus... the Hebrew name Yeshua (ישוע) means “salvation” or “Yahweh is salvation”
- When Jacob (Ya’acov in Hebrew) prayed in Genesis 49:18, he actually used the name of the coming Savior. He said, “I have waited for your salvation (Yeshua ישועה).” Jacob trusted in Yeshua even before Yeshua was born into this world!
- In Psalm 62:6, David too proclaims his faith in Yeshua, “He alone is my rock and my salvation (Yeshua ישועה), I will not be moved.” People living during Old Testament were redeemed by putting their faith in Yeshua.
- “Neither is there salvation (Yeshua ישועה; σωτηρία *soteria*) in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved," Acts 4:12

How can I have the name of God on me?

that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation. For the Scripture says, “Whoever believes in Him will not be disappointed.” For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him; for **“Whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved.”** Romans 10:9-13
